policies

- To be eligible for member rates, JCC membership must extend through the camper's last 2010 camp day.**
- All camp fees must be paid by March 1. Camp Wise reserves the right to cancel registrations with unpaid balances.
- Prior to March 1, all camp fees are refundable, including the deposit, for any reason. From March 1 – April 1 fees are refundable, but we will retain \$500. After April 1, all fees including the full deposit, are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- A 10% Sibling Discount will be applied to camp fees for families with multiple campers. The camper at the highest program cost will be at regular fees, and all siblings will be given the 10% discount. The SIT program is not eligible for a sibling discount.
- There are no deductions for a camper arriving late or leaving early.
- The Camp Director reserves the right to dismiss any camper without refund who:
 - Willfully disregards camp rules or endangers the safety of themselves or others
 - Physically, psychologically, or verbally abuses another member of the camp community
 - Destroys camp property or the property of another member of the camp community
 - Requires greater supervision than can reasonably be provided by camp staff
 - Possesses or consumes alcohol or illegal drugs while at camp
- Any camper who sustains an injury or illness while at camp, necessitating departure for the balance of the session, will have pro-rated fees refunded.
- Disclosure of all medical and psychological treatments, past and present is required.**
- A completed and signed health form must be received prior to the camper's arrival.
- In the event of an emergency, I authorize the Camp Director and the medical staff to act on my behalf according to their best judgment.
- Camp Wise is not responsible for loss or damage to camper's property.
- I authorize Camp Wise to take my child out of camp on supervised trips and activities.
- Camp Wise may use my photo, slide, or likeness of my child for promotional purposes.
