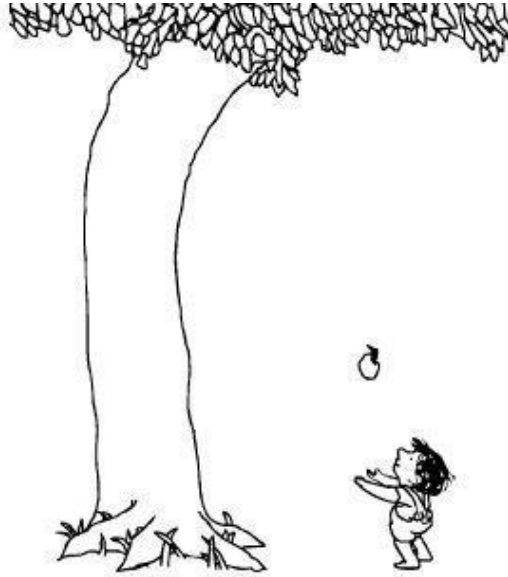


The Camp Wise Library is back!
