



2020 CAMP POLICIES

1. To be eligible for member rates, JCC membership must extend through the camper's last 2020 camp day.
2. All camp fees must be paid by March 1. Camp Wise reserves the right to cancel registrations with unpaid balances.
3. Prior to January 15, all camp fees are refundable, including the deposit, for any reason. From January 15 - February 15 fees are refundable, but we will retain \$500. After February 15, all fees including the full deposit, are non-refundable and non-transferable.
4. Starting at the second child each additional child receives a \$350 discount.
5. *Participants in the SIT or Israel Leadership Summer Programs are not eligible discounts including but not limited to: Sibling, Pay-in-Full, and Early Bird.*
6. For Campers enrolled in a 7-week session: Prior to January 15, all camp fees for a dropped session are refundable. From January 15 - February 15, fees for a dropped session are refundable, but we will retain \$500. If both sessions are dropped we will retain \$1000. After February 15, all fees for one or both dropped session, including the full deposit, are non-refundable and non-transferable.
7. There are no deductions for a camper arriving late or leaving early.
8. The Camp Director reserves the right to dismiss any camper without refund who: -
 - Willfully disregards camp rules or endangers the safety of themselves or others.
 - Physically, psychologically, or verbally abuses another member of the camp community.
 - Destroys camp property or the property of another member of the camp community.
 - Requires greater supervision than can reasonably be provided by camp staff.
 - Possesses or consumes alcohol or illegal drugs while at camp.
9. Any camper who sustains an injury or illness while at camp, necessitating departure for the balance of the session, will have pro-rated fees refunded.
10. Disclosure of all medical and psychological treatments, past and present is required.
11. A completed and signed health form must be received prior to the camper's arrival.
12. In the event of an emergency, I authorize the Camp Director and the medical staff to act on my behalf according to their best judgment.
13. Camp Wise is not responsible for loss or damage to camper's property.
14. I authorize Camp Wise to take my child out of camp on supervised trips and activities.
15. Camp Wise may use any photo, slide, video recording, audio recording, or likeness of my child for promotional purposes.
