

## **Frequently Asked Questions – Town Hall April 5<sup>th</sup>**

### **1. What are the expected pre-camp behaviors?**

- a. Pre-Camp Isolation: All campers/staff are required isolate for 7 days prior to their first day on camp. This includes remaining in isolation after your pre-camp COVID-19 test until your arrival day and time.
  - i. During pre-camp isolation, campers and staff should avoid physical contact with anyone outside their household. This includes school, day camp, sports, and other activities (inside or outside) with people outside of your household.
  - ii. During the pre-camp isolation, we ask household members to take appropriate physical distancing and preventative measures including limiting non-essential travel to reduce the risk of exposure.
- b. Screening: During pre-camp isolation campers/staff are required to keep a daily log of at-home health screenings. The log must be submitted prior to their first day for approval by the Camp Wise Health Center. The log will be available in your CampIn Touch account closer to the start of the summer.

### **2. If my camper is vaccinated, do they still have to follow the expected pre-camp behaviors?**

- a. Any member of our camp community who is vaccinated will still be expected to follow the same protocols before camp and during the summer.

### **3. Are you requiring staff to be vaccinated?**

- a. Based on guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and local health authorities, we are urging all who are eligible to get vaccinated. We are expecting that the majority of our staff will be vaccinated for summer.

### **4. Can you clarify what the testing process will be?**

- a. Pre Camp Test- 72 hours before the first day of Camp. Families are responsible for making sure their camper gets this test but Camp Wise will provide resources to local testing locations.
- b. First Day Test- Every camper will receive a Rapid Antigen Test on the first day of their session. Camp Wise is working with a local provider to conduct this test.
- c. 5 Day Test- The entire camp community will receive a Rapid Antigen Test 5 days into each session. Camp Wise is working with a local provider to conduct this test.

### **5. Will siblings and friends in different villages interact during camp?**

- a. Yes! Once we reach level two, we will be able to have Chofesh (free time) and campers will be able to see siblings and friends from other villages while maintaining mixing and masking.

### **6. What is the COVID fee and when will I be charged**

- a. The COVID fee this summer of up to \$200 per camper and may be charged to your account to cover the cost of COVID-19 medical expenses. More communication regarding this fee will be shared later this month.
